This gay & travel guide website is made and permanently updated since late 1998 in Prague, Czech Republic, in Central or Eastern Europe. At least twice per year we visit every place listed on this page and search for new places; we call every phone number and double check every detail. We hope it assists you to you in discovering this town. We enjoy to go everywhere and we are happy to share all the information with you to help you having a pleasant, uncomplicated and safe time without the hassle to figure out everything on your own. If you find anything that is not up2date please contact us right away. Tell us everything you know and we will go there and include it to this page. If you take pictures in Prague contact us as well. We may use them for this page. We try to describe every place as detailed as possible because we want you to know what to expect before you go to a venue where you have never been before. Also we list entrance fees and other prices. We also have a list of places and groups that do not exist or are not gay anymore (You may find them still listed in other guides).

Prague is the capital of the Czech Republic. Best time to visit is from early April to middle of November. Prague has a lively gay scene and the scene is differentiated ... You will find gay bars and dance clubs for a specific audience (like leather bars, rent boy bars, older audience, younger crowd). But, unfortunately, there has never been a Gay Pride in Prague until now.

All gay accommodations are in the centre of Prague and some gay bars, clubs, saunas, restaurants are close to each place. Prague has not one certain gay area, but there are a lot of them in Prague 1 (Old & New Town), 2/10 (Vinohrady) and 3 (Zizkov). A few are also in Prague 5, but we don't have accommodation there (other side of the river). We have carefully selected the places and we believe staying at gay accommodations makes it a lot easier to get access to Prague's gay life than if you stay isolated at regular hotels. At check in the staff will take the time to give you all the infos that you need to get started. Our Prague Gay Guide has also info about cafés, saunas and gyms, restaurants, media, groups and associations, condoms and lubricant, AIDS, events, cruising, sex shops, escorts, laws plus gay listings for the Czech countryside and links.

The chapter general tourist info gives you country facts (climate, time, money, national holidays); Info needed to travel to Czech Republic (visa, airlines, trains, busses, ships and cars); travel in Prague (map, public transport, taxis, rent a car, lost and found); and about communication (telecom, internet, dictionary, translations, interpreter, radio, TV) plus useful addresses (embassies, health, shopping, postal service, laundry, museums, galleries, tourist info) plus general links.

There is more we can do for you. First you should download and print the pdf file that we prepared and that includes all the info. Then you should subscribe to our newsletter. Don't worry, we send newsletters no more than four times per year. Next subscribe to the Gay Prague Yahoo Group. Use the mailing list to introduce yourself to other users of this site and let others introduce themselves to you. Share info and experiences, and meet online before you maybe meet in Prague. You may order books and maps online. You may also get latest event info for the period you stay in Prague. We have a great fluent English and German speaking gay tour guides who can take you around. They can make it easier for you to discover the city and the gay places and can answer all your questions. And we offer translations of texts and interpreter for meetings. If you like this website you may donate for this website. Every (also small) donation will help to keep this site alive and to add more content in the future.

You will find this sticker at several places in Prague. We distribute this sticker free of charge (there's no business behind this!) for places we really recommend :-)). Because the gay scene in Prague is permanently changing it can happen, that you'll find the sticker also at places, we have recommended in former times ... It's the best, if you orientate yourself at the small 'Recommended' logos within this guide. Decisions about which place to recommend or not is made by the GayGuide.Net Prague Team. Approximate every three month all people who are involved in creating this guide are coming together - Czechs as well as Immigrants who have choosed Prague to live here, - just 'professional tourists'.

GayGuide.Net Prague provides information on gay owned and gay operated guest houses & apartments in Prague. We have really carefully selected the places. All accommodations are in the centre of Prague and some gay bars, clubs, saunas, restaurants are close to each place. Prague does not have one certain gay area, but there are a lot of bars, clubs & saunas in Prague 1 (Old & New Town - Stare & Nove Mesto), Prague 2 & 10 (Winehill - Vinohrady) and Prague 3 (Zizkov). A few bars are also in Prague 5, but we don't have accommodation there (it's the other side of the river).

You need to decide if you prefer to stay at a guest house (breakfast included & staff is present for assistance) or if you prefer the privacy of an own apartment (assistance is provided as well as apartment owners are all reachable by cell phones).

How to make a reservation (gay accommodation)

Please review the websites of the accommodations below and choose the place you prefer most. If you are flying into Prague, please check first with the airline to insure flights are available before you request a reservation. This helps to avoid your having to change reservations.

If the place is available you will receive a confirmation via email including all the info you will need: Addresses, phone numbers, directions, check in details.

In case, your first preference is not available you will receive offers via email for other places. You will never loose out!

Gejzeer dance club, the Cafe Vnitřní Kruh, the Piano Bar and Sauna Marco. Opened in early 1999 and owned by Czech gays, they are working permanently on improvements as well as on their English and German language skills. They also run the Arco Cafe and they have three internet terminals where you can check your emails. It's a quiet location, two tram stops from the Metro station Namesti Miru. You need to reserve in advance! Open all year, Reservations in advance required.

Airport Transfer

Airport Transfer in Prague

GayGuide.Net Prague provides in cooperation with Rainbow Travel a private airport transfer to every place in the city. The driver will wait for you in the arrival hall, having a name plate with your name. The fee is EUR 29 per car (up to 3 persons). A return trip is EUR 49. We provide this just because it's maybe nice to have someone who is gay awaiting you in Prague and you may talk about the gay scene during the trip to your accommodation. It is possible that your accommodation provider offers a free transfer or charges less as a part of his advertising. Please check this first!

If you have a confirmed reservation for Arco Guest House, Old Town Apartments or Prague Center Guest Residence please visit their webpage to request the airport transfer. Rates for transfers to these places are lower and the drivers are different! For this reason you should not fill this form if you stay at one of them.

Bars & Clubs

General Security Advice

At most clubs in Prague you will get a 'drink ticket' - also called consumption card. Your consumption will be noted on this paper. Payment usually is when you leave the place. If you lose the ticket usually a high penalty fee is required. Make sure to be careful with your drink tickets and also check for padding of the bills.

If you take someone to your place please take care about your valuables. If your room or apartment has a safe or if there is a safe at the reception of your guest house or hotel please use it.

If you take a sexworkers service do not force him to do any practice he don't want. Agree on everything in advance: the cost, the sexual practices wanted, and the time. This prevents many problems from occurring.

Laws

Laws in Czech Republic

Homosexuality has been decriminalized in 1961. Laws against homosexual relations have been repealed in 1990. The legal minimum age of consent (for heterosexual and homosexual relations alike) is 15 years (if no money is involved). Additionally it is an offence to expose a minor (under 18) to the „danger of depravation“ by enabling him an „idle or indecent life“ or by seducing him into such a life (Art. 217 CC; two years jail). According to the case-law the „danger of depravation“ must be the result of an intensive longer-lasting behaviour by the perpetrator causing in the youth habits, preferences and interests leading to his moral decline and to his inability to lead an independant life.

Homosexuality is considered a taboo by the majority of the population. Prague is a liberal city where many gay Czechs choose to live. There are no laws concerning tourists with HIV/AIDS.

Prostitution and Promotion of Prostitution is legal, if the prostitute is at least 18 years old.

Registred partnerships have been discussed twice in the Parliament, but the law didn't come realized yet.

Travel to Czech Republic

Entry & Visa & Custom

Since 2004 May 1st Australian and Canadian citizens do not need a visa for a 30 days tourist stay anymore!

Please contact the Czech Embassy in your country to make sure, that you are informed about any visa requirements that apply for your citizenship. If you are passing other countries on your way to the Czech Republic (e.g. if you travel by train) make sure to inform yourself about these

countries too. The following are the regulation so far we know, but we can't guarantee it.

A new law on foreigners residence in the Czech Republic and visa requirements came into effect on January 1, 2000. Beginning this year applications for short-term, long-term, and permanent residence visas must be filed through Czech Embassies and consulates outside the Czech Republic.

Visitors from a number of countries do not need a visa for a tourist/business visit to the Czech Republic for a limited period of time (see limits to stay in the country without visa for your country below). If you wish to stay in the country over that limit and up to 30/90/180 days there are two options:

a) you can apply for exit visa (vyjezdni vizum) with the Foreigners' Police in the Czech Republic no later than three days before your limited stay in the country without visa expires ; exit visa allows you to stay in the country for up to 90 days including previous stay in the country;

b) you can apply for a short-term visa for up to 90 days at a Czech Embassy or consulate before arriving to the Czech Republic. (Warning: visa application processing may take up to 90-120 days).

Foreigners' Police Office, Olsanska 2, Praha 3, 130 00.

If you wish to stay in the country longer than 30 (or 90 or 180) days, you must apply for a long-term visa over 90 days which allows you to stay in the country for up to one year and is also required for purposes of working or studying in the Czech Republic for longer than 90 days. You must apply for this visa at a Czech Embassy or consulate. (Note: This may be done through ANY Czech Embassy or consulate around the world, i.e. not only in your home country).

Renewals of visa over 90 days are handled by the Foreigners' Police office. The Act on Residence of Aliens in the Territory of the Czech Republic can be found in English at: <http://www.mvcr.cz/english.html>

Tourists and visitors from the following countries may visit the Czech Republic without a visa for a limited period of time. All other requirements apply to them as above.

Airport Transfer

Choose between these options A local bus 119 (To/From the Dejvicka Metro stop, the last stop on the green A line daily between 4:27 a.m. and 11.40 p.m.; it takes 21 minutes). If you go from the center to the airport make sure, that you not get out before the very last stop. The first buildings with the airport signs are almost 2 miles from the international terminal. A single trip is 12 CZK per person.

A local bus 100 (To/From the Zlicin Metro stop, the last stop on the yellow B line. A single trip is 12 CZK per person.

Cedaz operates a 'Express Airport Bus' (Phone: 220114296) picks up passengers at the airport. Departure at Airport Prague between 6 a.m. and 9 p.m. every 30 minutes. They'll bring you into the city's center to both the Namesti Republiky and Dejvicka metro stops. RETOUR: The Shuttle stop is close to the CSA-Building across the Marriott Hotel at Namesti Republiky and goes daily between 5:30 a.m. til 9:30 p.m. every 30 minutes via Metro stop Dejvicka (Metro A) to Letiste Ruzyně (Airport Prague). A single trip is 90 CZK per person.

Cedaz also operated 'Shuttle Vans', that cost 480 CZK for 1 to 4 persons and 960 CZK for 5 to 8 persons. The price is divided by the number of people, therefore if there was just 4 people it would cost 480 CZK divided by 4 so 120 CZK per person. If the bus is full (8 persons) then 120 CZK per person.

There isn't any other service than taxi service which stops exactly where people want to go. Taxis charge a flat rate per zone. Prague 1 is 650 CZK, Prague 2 is 720 CZK etc. But you should reconfirm the rate with the driver.

Gas/petrol (benzin) comes in both leaded and unleaded, called „natural“. Both may come in 2 „flavors“ as well: Super and Special. Diesel fuel is called „nafta“ and is often served from different pumps for trucks/lorries and for passenger cars.

Public Transport

There are 3 metro lines in Prague & a lot of tram- (since 1891) and bus lines. And a cableway (Or is it a funicular? Sorry for our lack of english skills ...

Tickets are valid for all means of transportation, but cannot be purchased from bus- or tram drivers. You have to buy them in advance at all metro stops, news- and tabac shops, some groceries, anywhere you see the red-and-yellow „DP“ sticker or at yellow vending machines (in metro stations and some places with high density of traffic; Press once for the ticket you want, twice if you want two tickets..., and then press the ‚enter‘ button!

Coins only, but they do give change). Tickets need to be stamped before entering the metro or after entering trams & busses.

Plain-clothes inspectors do ticket checks, - penalty is 200 CZK if you're travelling without a valid ticket. Ask for his or her photo ID badge!

Metros are going between 5 a.m. and midnight, trams at day and night: Night trams are visible through a „5“ at the beginning (51, 52, 53 ...), they have 8 different lines and most of them crossing each other at „Lazarska“ in the center of Prague, where you can change trains. They approach every 40 minutes.

The 12 nightbuslines (501, 502 ...) don't have one similar central stop, but most of them stop at the top of Wenceslas Square (near Muzeum metro) and around the corner from I.P. Pavlova metro stop.

Fees: 12 CZK is the price for a ticket for a 60 minutes ride at weekdays; but between 8 p.m. and 5 a.m. as well as on Saturdays and Sundays 90 minutes - and you can change trains within this time.

8 CZK you have to pay for a single 15 minutes ride without changing trains and for max. 4 metro stops.

We recommend not to use single tickets - a 24-hour pass is available at ticket machines. 70 CZK 1 day

Taxis

Not long time ago it was definitely risky to hire a taxi in Prague, but fortunately since 98, 1st of April there are regulations. If you take a taxi for a trip within Prague and you do not go out of Prague's borders you can hire a cab without being scared if you pay attention to the following: Prior to setting off, the taximeter must be reset and the figure 30 CZK will appear on the display. There is for all taxis within the city of Prague a regulated maximum rate: A One-off boarding charge is max. 30; 1 kilometer within the city boundaries is max. 22 CZK and Waiting is max. 4 CZK per minute. Make sure you ask for a receipt before paying. Receipts have to be printed out by the taximeter since 98, April. Taxis ordered through the dispatcher are cheaper (updated 20th of Oct 2002).
